Guangzhou ,Shanghai, Suzhou, Zhujiyajiao,P ayu,
Baomoyuan, Shunde, Dongguan, Xianggang

28 Oct: Sydney→Guangzhou→Shanghai

Hotel: Central Hotel or similar 4 * (4N)

Morning flight CZ326 (0950/1700) to Guangzhou, Upon arrival into Guangzhou. You met your national guide at the airport and transit domestic flight CZ3547 (1930/2130) to Shanghai. After arrival, transfer to the hotel.

29 Oct: Shanghai (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit the Shanghai World Financial Center. Shanghai World Financial Center is located in the center of the Zone. With 101 floors above ground level and soaring to a height of 492m, this project embodies Mori Building's original "Vertical Garden City" concept and incorporates the company's vast know-how and experience. Then visit the Urban Planning Exhibition Hall. Move on to the Zoo to visit EXPO pandas. They were all born after the 2008 Wenchuan earthquake.



30 Oct: Shanghai (B/D)

After breakfast, whole day visit 2010 EXPO. The slogan of the Shanghai World EXPO is "better city, better life", representing the common wish of the whole humankind for a better living in future urban environments. Although the world EXPO has a long history, it has never been held in Asia. In addition, this is first World Expo be held in the developing country. The Shanghai 2010 World Expo will leave you an impressive day. (Pick up by EXPO car)



31 Oct: Shanghai (B/D)

After breakfast, whole day visit 2010 EXPO. (Pick up by EXPO car)

1 Nov: Shanghai/Suzhou (B/L/D)

Hotel: Holiday Inn Youlian Suzhou or similar 4 * (1N)

After breakfast, visit the famous Humble Administrator's Garden, a piece of classic work in Suzhou gardens. Its gardening art occupies very significant position in Chinese gardening history and the garden represents the historical characteristics and achievement in China. Next move to Shan Tang Street, featured with Chinese traditional water town style. Then continue to Silk Factory.



2 Nov: Suzhou/Zhujiajiao/Shanghai→Guangzhou (B/L/D)

Hotel: Mandarin Hotel or similar 4 * (1N)

After breakfast, visit the Zhujiajiao -- a water village on the outskirts of Shanghai, and was formed about 1,700 years ago. 36 stone bridges and numerous rivers line in Zhujiajiao, and thousands of ancient buildings still line along the riverbanks today. After visit in Shanghai, transfer to the airport for flight CZ3504 (1945/2205) to Guangzhou.



3 Nov: Guangzhou/Shunde (B/L/D)

Hotel: Shunde Country Garden Holiday Resort or similar 4 *(2N)

After breakfast, visit Baomo Garden. The Garden is a large garden of Lingnan style of antiqueness and elegance featuring palace culture of Qing Dynasty, Lingnan gardening, Lingnan ancient architecture, marks of Pearl River delta as well as art collections belonging to ancient and modern times. Move on to the Yuving Garden which is also known as the Yuyin Mountain House and is located in Nancun Town, Panyu. The garden and the house shares a history which is around 130 years old. Lunch served with Buffet. Move on to the Lianhuashan Guanyin Appeasing the Sea.



4 Nov: Shunde (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit Qinghui Garden, one of the four major Qing gardens in Guangdong. Built in 1800, it is typical of the Lingnan style of garden construction. Outwardly it looks just like another ordinary garden. Inside, however, it turns out to be an all-embracing world. Move on to Foshan Ancestral Temple. Then visit Liang Yuan Garden. Liang Yuan Garden, with a complex of buildings and gardens which used to be the residence of the Liangs' extended family, wealthy residents of Foshan. The gardens are a good example of exquisite oriental gardens and landscaping while the buildings are also good example of traditional Cantonese homes of the wealthy. Both the gardens and the buildings are well worth the visit.

5 Nov: Shunde/Dongguan (B/L/D)

Hotel: Chinese Hotel or similar 5 * (1N)

After breakfast, coach to Dongguan. Visit Ke Garden, Humen Bridge, Sites of the Pool of Lin Zexu Destroying Opium and the Humen Batteries.



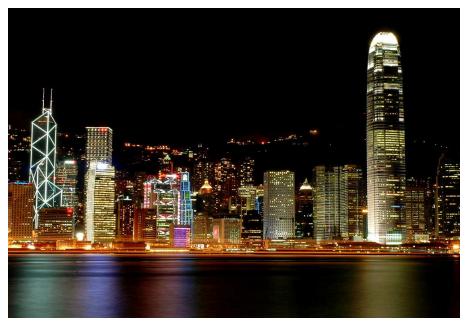
6 Nov: Dongguan/Hongkong (B)

Hotel: on your own arrangement

After breakfast, coach to Hongkong. After arrival, visit on your own arrangement.

7 Nov—9 Nov: Hongkong

Free explore.



10 Nov: Hongkong/Guangzhou (L/D)

Hotel: Mandarin Hotel or similar 4*(5N)

Coach back to Guangzhou. Visit the **Yuexiu Park** which is the largest park in downtown Guangzhou. Visit **the Five-Ram Sculpture** which is one of the most famous structures in Guangzhou and the **Zhenhai Tower** which is one of the landmarks of Guangzhou city. Move on to **The Tomb of Western Han Nanyue King**, **The Memorial Hall of Dr. Sun Yat-sen**. The memorial hall was built by the local people of Guangzhou and overseas Chinese to commemorate Dr Sun Yat-sen, the great forerunner of Chinese Revolution.



11 Nov: Guangzhou (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit **Yuntai Garden** which is located at the foot of the Baiyun Mountain. The garden is notable for its wide variety of colorful flowers and rare species of plants. Yuntai Garden is characterized by rich artistic features with both ancient and modern culture and Western and Oriental style structures. Lunch served with **Rice noodles**.



You can also watch how the rice noodles been made. Then visit the **Xi Guan** and free shop in the commercial center. Enjoy the performance in the new **Guangzhou Opera House**. (Programs to be told & tickets on your own expense).

12 Nov: Guangzhou (B)

Watch the Opening Ceremony of Asian Games. (Details to be told & tickets on your own expense)



13 Nov—14 Nov: Guangzhou (B)

Watch events of Asian Games: gymnastics, ping-pong, swimming, etc. (Tickets on your own expense)

15 Nov: Guangzhou→Sydney (B)

Free explore until transferred to the airport , evening flight back to Sydney **CZ325 (2105/0930+1)**.

16 Nov: Sydney
