2011 Hepatitis C Awareness Week

According to the statistics of the World Health Organization, the infection rate of the global hepatitis C is 3%, and it is estimated that 170 million people have been infected with hepatitis C virus. In China, the anti-HCV positive rate is 3.2% among the general population. Nearly 40 million people have been suffering from hepatitis C, i.e. among 30 people, one person is a hepatitis patient. The most worried thing is that, at present, 12% - 20% people are still not aware of hepatitis C. The Annual conference of the Asian - Pacific Association for the Study of the Liver warned of all the mankind: Pay Close Attention to the Danger of Hepatitis C.
